Clients who are on a low income and/or socially

- · Clients who are experiencing symptoms related to mild to moderate mental health concerns (excludes intellectual disability, dementia, personality disorders, complex posttraumatic stress disorder)
- · Clients who are NOT currently in crisis or need of urgent care

- Client must be a resident of specific RACF
- · Clients at risk of mild to moderate mental illness
- A diagnosed mental illness, with mild to moderate symptoms of a common mental illness (excludes dementia, delirium & complex mental illness)
- For vulnerable **older** people (without access to a support person they feel comfortable with and trust), who need intensive support and assistance to access aged care and other services
- Must be eligible for government-funded aged care

- Clients 18 years or older
- Clients diagnosed with a cardiovascular condition. diabetes, respiratory condition or morbid obesity
- · Referrals to Amity Health by a GP. Nurse Practitioner or Remote Area Nurse, and have a GP Management Plan
- Clients need care coordination support to help manage their condition
- Live in above regions

- · Clients must identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- · Clients with chronic disease/s including diabetes, cardiovascular disease, chronic kidney disease and chronic respiratory disease
- · Clients must have a current **GP Management Plan**
