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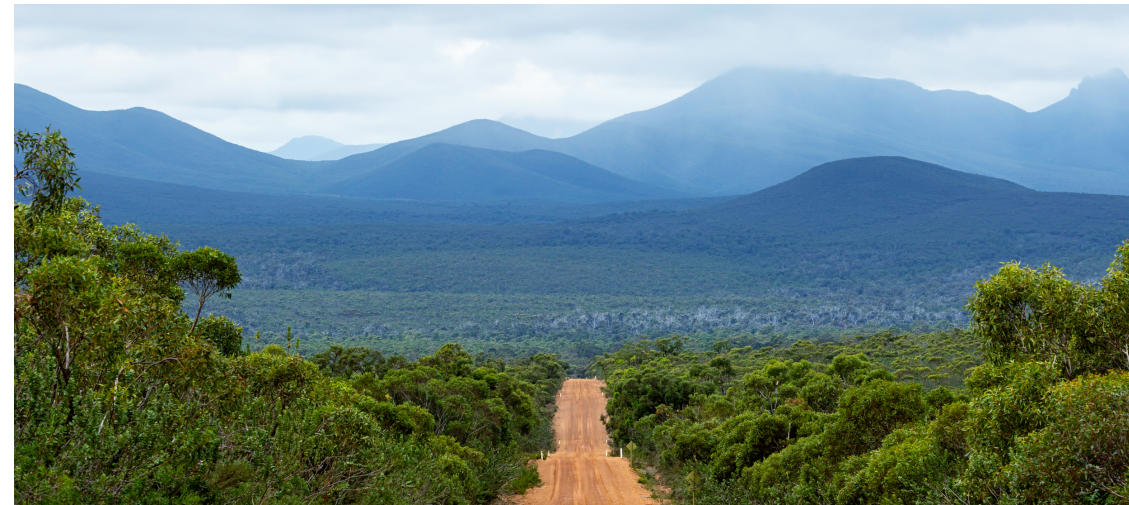

About Us

Amity Health is a **not-for-profit organisation** providing primary health services and programs in 3 regional areas in WA:

- the **Great Southern** (head office in Albany, office in Denmark),
- the **Wheatbelt** (offices in Merredin, Moora, Narrogin & Northam) with outreach to the coastal Wheatbelt, and
- the **South-East Coastal Goldfields** regions (office in Esperance),

We have also recently commenced a program in the **Midwest** region to provide the Primary Mental Health Care Program (Connections Count) for some Residential Aged Care Facilities in Geraldton.

Amity Health has **both funded and fee for service** programs and services available to children and families, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, and people with chronic conditions and mental health issues.

Visiting Specialists (Albany)



In addition to our Amity Health clinicians, we have **clinic rooms in Albany**, offering a range of visiting specialists.

They include, but are not limited to, Vascular Surgeon, Podiatrist, Audiologist, Dermatologist, Orthopaedic Surgeon and Respiratory Physician with specialist spirometry services.
