- the Wheatbelt (offices in Merredin, Moora, Narrogin & Northam) with outreach to the coastal Wheatbelt, and
- the South-East Coastal Goldfields regions (office in Esperance).

We have also recently commenced a program in the Midwest region to provide the Primary Mental Health Care Program (Connections Count) for some Residential Aged Care Facilities in Geraldton.

Amity Health has both funded and fee for service programs and services available to children and families, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, and people with chronic conditions and mental health issues.
