OUR MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELLING PROGRAM



PROVIDING FREE COUNSELLING

through the Integrated Primary Mental Health Care (IPMHC) Program



NORTHAM

This service is not suitable to those currently in crisis or requiring urgent assistance.

WHAT IS THE MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELLING PROGAM?

It's a program offering free support for people who are experiencing mental health challenges.

Our clinicians will work alongside you with the aim to help you optimise your mental health and wellbeing. Our program is designed to support you through two options.

WHAT ARE THE PROGRAM OPTIONS?

- 1. Wellbeing Counselling (self or GP referral)
- 2. Mental Health Therapy (GP or other health professional referral)
- 3. Clinical Care Coordination (GP or Psychiatrist)

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

People who:

- are struggling with mental health issues
- · are experiencing financial hardship
- live in the Great Southern or Wheatbelt regions of Western Australia
- are not accessing other mental health services
- are aged 7 years and above

OPTION ONE

WELLBEING COUNSELLING Self-referral

Our self-referral Wellbeing Counselling option is available to people 18+ years. We offer 3 sessions that will help you to focus on the here and now, providing you with support, education and skill development to help improve your mental wellbeing.

This program can help you if you:

- have low mood or feelings of sadness
- find it difficult to do everyday things because of how you feel
- worry more than usual
- are unable to relax because of your thoughts and feelings
- avoid doing things because it makes you feel anxious

REFERRALS FOR OPTION ONE

- We accept self-referrals or you can contact our front office team who will be very happy to discuss your needs.
- GPs and other health professionals are also able to refer to this service.

Once your referral form is submitted, we will contact you within 7 business days to discuss how we can help you with your wellbeing plan.

OPTION TWO

MENTAL HEALTH THERAPY

Sometimes you may need a little more help especially if you've previously experienced mental health challenges, or you are currently struggling with your mental health.

Our Mental Health Therapy is for 7 years and above, and includes 6 - 10 sessions. This may be a good fit for you.

We suggest you have a chat with your GP who can help determine if this program is the right option. Your GP can then provide a referral into this program.

REFERRALS FOR OPTION TWO

- A referral from a GP, Psychiatrist or Paediatrician is required.
- Referrals from other health professionals will be considered.

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OPTION THREE - NORTHAM ONLY

CLINICAL CARE COORDINATION

This service is designed to support GPs in the management of individuals with **severe and persistent mental health conditions** for those who are stable, and not in a crisis situation.

We can provide integrated services that cover a range of needs such as:

- Monitoring of mental and physical health
- Liaison with other health providers as part of a shared-care arrangement
- Linking to other services as required, e.g. drug and alcohol, personal support, physical health
- Provision of health literacy and education to individuals, families and carers
- Medication management
- Managing clinical deterioration and facilitating specialist consultation/care

REFERRALS FOR OPTION THREE

- A referral from a GP or psychiatrist is required to access this service.
- Referrals from other health professionals will also be considered, pending endorsement by the individual's GP.
