What is an Occupational Therapist (OT)?

As humans, we spend each day 'doing things.'

This includes

- taking care of ourselves (brushing teeth, showering, sleeping, etc.)
- productivity (going to work, volunteering, school) and,
- leisure (reading, socializing, swimming)



Sometimes we are unable to do the things we need or want to do due to illness, disability, or other factors such as anxiety, as an example.

Occupational Therapists are qualified to help you to problem solve, work around challenges, support you in participating in activities, to enable you to live a meaningful life.

- fine and gross motor coordination
- sensory processing
- self-regulation
- attention and concentration
- sleep
- a range of mild to moderate disabilities

- play and social skills
- school visits, groups, and family therapy are available
- self-care skills such as dressing, meal times and brushing teeth.

SELF REFERRALS

Contact our team directly.

If applicable, Private Health Insurance will cover your OT appointments depending on the level of your cover.

GP REFERRALS

You and/or your child may be eligible for a GP Management Plan or a Team Care Arrangement. See your GP to discuss your options and eligibility

- you can access up to five visits and will be provided with partial Medicare rebates.
- NDIS REFERRALS
 Self-referral for participants with NDIS plans

Our Occupational Therapists can:

- provide a range of services in the community and in aged care facilities
- help you to regain or enhance your skills after events such as hip replacement, stroke, or injury
- assist you to access adaptive equipment such as mobility aids and provide education around its use and how it can help you

- simple home modification recommendations
- simple equipment recommendations

- sleep management
- your management of conditions such as arthritis, osteoporosis, motor neurone disease and acquired brain injury
