- Our Speech Pathologists work with children and adults who have communication disorders, including difficulties with speaking, listening, understanding language, reading, writing, social skills, stuttering and using voice
- They work with people who have difficulty communicating due to developmental delays, stroke, brain injuries, learning disability, intellectual disability, cerebral palsy, degenerative neurological conditions and hearing loss, as well as other problems that can affect speech and language
- They provide assessment and therapy for people of all ages who experience difficulties swallowing food and drink safely
- Assisting clients explore a variety of alternative communication options

The Referral Options

Our Speech Pathology services accept the following referral options:

SELF REFERRALS

Families and individuals can self-refer by completing our referral form which can be found on our website.

GP REFERRALS

Visit your GP to see if you are eligible for a Chronic Disease Management Plan and/or a Team Care Plan. Under these plans you can access up to five visits that will be partly covered through Medicare

NDIS REFERRALS

Amity Health is an approved NDIS provider and our speech pathology services can be accessed using this funding where appropriate.

- face-to-face appointments at Amity Health Albany & Denmark
- occasional home and school visits if necessary
- telehealth

Speech Pathology for Adults

At Amity Health our Speech Pathologist Georgia can provide a range of services for adults in the community and in aged care facilities by;

- Assisting clients with swallowing difficulties
- Assisting clients with speech and language impairments resulting from stroke and degenerative conditions such as Parkinson's Disease
- Assisting clients with other communication difficulties, including challenges using voice, with hearing and fluency
- Assisting non-verbal clients explore a variety of alternative communication options
